Black Country Lungs is a new photo-book and exhibition of photographs and moving images made in collaboration with Multistory and Dutch photographer Corinne Noordenbos. It tells the stories of people living with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) in the Black Country through photographs and first hand testimonies. For her first UK commission, Corinne photographed people in hospitals and in their homes between June 2015 and May 2017.

At the launch, Corinne will guide us around the outdoor exhibition located in the wonderful surroundings of The Shakespeare Garden (adjacent to Lightwoods House), books will be presented to project participants, the Singing for Lung Health Choir (Wolverhampton) will perform and afternoon tea and scones will be served.
